GENERAL COUNCIL TO HOLD SOUTH AMERICA AREA MEETING

The main theme of the event will be “improving our management in order to better serve the poor”

The city of *Foz do Iguaçu*, situated in the province of Parana (Brazil) will be the location for a historic event within the scope of the SSV General Council in 2010 in South America. The event will be organised by the International Vice-presidency Area “South America Equatorial”, under member Renato Lima de Oliveira. The 1st SSV Area Meeting will bring together the main leaders of the region’s National Councils. The theme of the event will be “improving our management in order to better serve the poor”.



The Meeting will take place on the 14th and 15th February 2010 in Carima Hotel. Five people have been invited from each of the countries of the Vice-presidency Area (Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Ecuador, Chile, Paraguay, Peru and Uruguay): The National President, National Spiritual Advisor, National Youth Delegate, National Training Coordinator and National Twinning Coordinator.



Alongside the national leaders that have already confirmed their attendance, the meeting will also be attended by various international guests, such as Carmela Addante (Canada) – the Twinning Continental Coordinator; Julien Spiewak (France) – International Youth Delegate; and further Vincentian representatives from other regions. “It will be an excellent opportunity to exchange experiences from country to country and to pass a united action plan regarding the region” according to Renato Lima.
