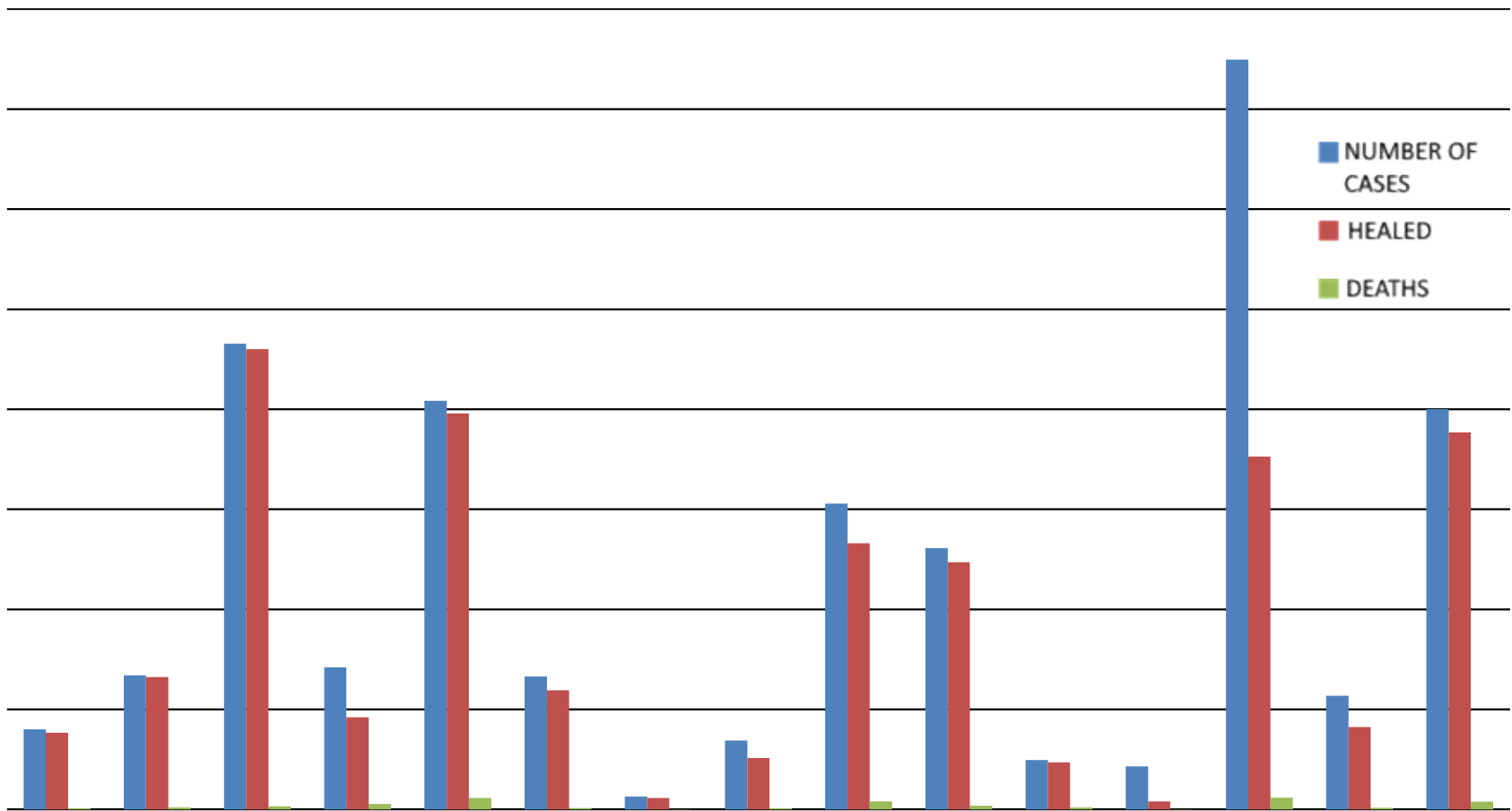


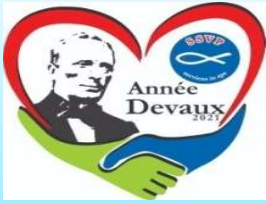

Discoveries

1. Confrontation with the second wave of Covid 19
2. Increased morbidity and mortality
3. Finding more cure rates
4. Partial curfew
5. Update of a treatment protocol validated by the Ministry of Health
6. Launch of the anti - Covid vaccine

Consequences

1. Reminder on respecting barrier gestures
2. Explanation on the three forms of Covid 19 (Mild-moderate-severe)
3. Conduction and implementation of the green line for communications
4. Sharing of the inventory of treatment centers
5. Inventory of vaccination points
6. Home treatment
7. Reluctance to get vaccinated because of side effects (Covishield)



Preventive action

1. Church

- ❖ Celebrate Mass in the open air if possible with social distancing from 1 to 2m
- ❖ Hand washing with hydroalcoholic gel at the entrance

2. School environment

- ❖ Respect for barrier gestures
- ❖ Pause recreation
- ❖ 1 student for each table

3. Public place

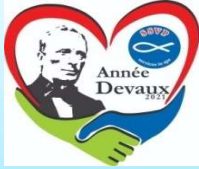
- ❖ Respect for barrier gestures

4. Public transport

- ❖ Limit of the number of travelers

5. Restaurant

- ❖ Barrier gestures
- ❖ Continuous disinfection of the room, furniture, dishes



Home prevention

If there is a Covid patient with mild symptoms:

- Seek medical consultation in case of doubt or unusual symptoms
- Patient isolation
- Avoid visitors
- Maintain telephone contact with the attending physician
- Correctly follow the medical prescription
- Avoid shaking hands and kissing visitors
- Confinement of 7 days after recovery confirmed by a doctor
- PCR for contacts and treatment if necessary

Good home practices

- Sweep the house often
- Hand washing with soap as often as possible
- Put a carpet cleaning at the entrance
- Air the rooms at least 30 minutes 3 times a day
- Limit visitors
- Leave shoes at the door after each exit
- Take off the clothes and hang them out in the sun or wash them in a soap near each exit
- Steam inhalation with medicinal plants
- Track Covid information and data.



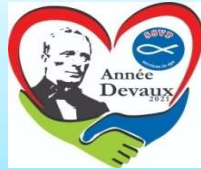
POVERTY

Effects

- Economic constraints
- Lack of money
- Job Loss
- Health barrier limiting street vendors to sell their goods
- Rampant inflation (increase in PPN prices)
- Children dropping out of school due to school closures
- Increase in homeless people and street children
- Malnutrition of women and children
- Long wait at health centers to seek free care
- Death due to Covid

Solutions

- Food support
- Home visit to patients and counseling
- Contact the Ministry of Population to direct the homeless in the homeless centers
- Collaboration with neighborhood community workers to facilitate immediate care for the poor
- Demonstration and tasting of food supplements (SOY milk-cereals for children)
- Awareness of the virtues of medicinal plants for inhalation-friction: (cinnamomum camphora-eucalyptus globulus -ocimum granatum)
- Inventory of accommodation centers



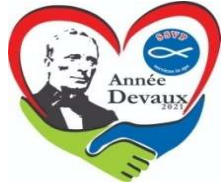

Responses from SSVP CONFERENCES in the FUTURE

Short term

- ✓ Priority pressing needs: social component-Health-Education-food.
- ✓ Support for the creation of income-generating activities: (making and selling masks)
- ✓ Training and professional reintegration
- ✓ For subsidized schools, conferences: reinforcement of the skills of teachers and provision of photocopier and printer for homework in the event of confinement
- ✓ Promote Anti-Covid Vaccination for target groups
- ✓ Fight against disinformation and rumors about the anti-Covid vaccine



Responses from SSVP Conferences in the Future

In the medium and long term

- Search for water points and drinking water supply
- Agricultural training in rural areas and provision of seeds after training
- Support for the creation of small businesses with a start-up package
- Multiplication of primary schools in rural areas
- Sewing school in urban areas
- Pastry training and provision of adequate materials
- Rural electrification by solar panels to ensure the safety of the rural population
